

# 2018 TAX INFORMATION

## TAX PAYMENTS

- We will accept Check or Money Order only. Please make payable to the Town of Winchester
- You can mail your tax payment in the enclosed addressed envelope
- You can drop off your tax payment in the secure Drop-Off box at the Town Hall
- You can pay in person at the Town Hall. I will be collecting payments:
  - 1:00 pm – 5:00 pm Dec. 18, 19, 26
  - 8:00 am – 12:00 pm Dec. 21, 27, 28, 31
- If you make payment by mail or drop-off box and you would like a receipt, please include a stamped, self-addressed envelope with your payment
- If your escrow check is more than your bill, the difference will be refunded to you

## LOTTERY TAX CREDIT

- If you have lived in your home since January 1, 2018 you should have a Lottery Tax Credit. If you do not and you are entitled to one, please let me know when you pay your taxes. Lottery credit can be given at that time

## PAYMENT DATES

- **First Installments** are to be paid to the Town of Winchester Treasurer by January 31, 2019
- **Second Installment or Balance Due** is to be paid to the Winnebago County Treasurer by July 31, 2019. I will provide you with an addressed envelope for the Winnebago County Treasurer's office
- **Full Payments** are to be paid to the Town of Winchester Treasurer by January 31, 2019
- Envelopes postmarked by December 31, 2018 will be credited in 2018 for tax purposes

## DOG LICENSE

- Wisconsin State Statue #174.05 requires all DOGS 5 months or older to have a license

- Please include an application, fee, and a **copy** of the certificate for rabies vaccination for each pet
