The Town of Winchester Fire Department is accepting applications for the position of Volunteer Fire Fighter. Basic requirements:

- Completion of High School diploma or GED
- Applicant must be at least 18 years old
- Must be able to attend department training on the first Wednesday evening of each month and other training dates as scheduled.
- Must be able to attend truck inspections the second Monday every other month, as assigned.
- Candidates must possess a Wisconsin Fire Fighter 1 certificate within one year of hire.
- Applicant must also possess a valid Wisconsin Driver's license.
- Only paper applications will be accepted, which can be obtained from Chief Mathison.

Essential Job Functions

- Responds to alarms and assists in the suppression of fires, including rescue, entry, ventilating, salvage work, overhaul work, and cleanup.
- Assists in inspecting and maintaining fire apparatus and equipment, cleaning fire station and grounds; helps check all equipment and apparatus; performs simple and routine maintenance.
- Tests hoses, breathing and related firefighting equipment.
- Inspects, cleans and maintains fire hoses, pumps, and related equipment.
- Participates in continuing training and instruction programs by attending scheduled drills and classes.
- Prepares and submits required reports.
- Conducts station tours for the public, schools and community;
- May be assigned to a special area or projects as needed.

JOB RELATED PHYSICAL ACTIVITY REQUIREMENTS: This position involves heavy work requiring the employee to exert up to 100 pounds of force occasionally and less force frequently to move objects. Physical activity related to this position may include climbing, balancing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, crawling, reaching, standing, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, grasping, feeling, talking, hearing, and repetitive motions. Sufficient visual acuity is required to operate machinery and perform skilled tasks of a non-repetitive nature. An employee in this position will be exposed to indoor and outdoor environmental conditions including extreme heat and cold; subject to hazards including exposure to working mechanical parts, electrical currents, and exposure to chemicals; subject to fumes, odors, dusts, mists, gases, or poor ventilation; subject to exposure to oils and cutting fluids; required to wear a respirator; and may be subject to frequently working in close quarters. An employee in this position could be "reasonably anticipated" as a result of performing their job duties to face contact with blood and other potentially infectious materials.
