Intact Males and Females \$10.00 each
Multiple Dog License \$40.00 (Max 12 Tags)

Any dog registered on/after April 1st will be charged a \$10.00 late fee unless it is a new dog.

Fiber Optic Broadband coming to Winchester

US Internet (USI) has applied for and received Broadband expansion grant funding on for the Town of Winchester.

Construction is scheduled to begin in early 2023 with completion expected within the calendar year. The service area proposes constructing 18 miles of new fiber optic to service approximately 491 homes/businesses. Maps of the service area are available at the Town Hall and online at www.townofwinchesterwi.com. USI will also be mailing more information soon.

New Fire Department Equipment and Parking Building Construction

The Town of Winchester is constructing a new 42' x 80' building to park and store equipment for the Fire Department and First Responders. Using a combination of ARPA funds and the sale of land, the construction is being funded at no cost to the taxpayer.

The building will provide the needed space to allow for proper equipment storage and the expansion of Fire Department and First Responder Services.

Snowplowing Rules to Know

Pushing snow onto or across roads from private driveways can cause accidents, death, and/or snowplow and vehicle damage and is **prohibited by Wisconsin Law Statutes 86.01, 86.07, 346.94, and/or 941.03.**

Snow should be managed on your own property. Please do not place snow piles in the roadside ditches. Avoid penalty and liability and cooperate towards safer roads.
