Preferred Payment Method: **Checks or Money Orders** payable to the *Town of Winchester*.
Cash payments accepted for **exact amount** only.

First Installments or Full Payments are due by January 31, 2024.

Options for making tax payments are as follows:

In-Person: At the Town office.

Beginning December 18:

Mondays from 2:00-5:00 p.m.

Tuesdays from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Thursdays from 10:00 to 1:00 p.m.

and

Saturday, Dec. 30, Jan. 20, and 27

from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Any dog registered on/after April 1st will be charged a \$10.00 late fee unless it is a new dog.

Contaminated Recycling = Increased Costs

Town of Winchester residents pay for and the Town contracts with Waste Management for weekly residential waste and recycling collections of materials as identified in the *Winnebago County Waste & Recycling Guide*.

Recently, there has been an increase of non-recyclable materials mixed in the recycling carts. Drivers have cameras in their trucks to view dumped materials and when they see contamination, the collections cannot be processed as recycling and the entire batch is then handled as trash. The cost to process trash at the County facility is more than 10 times the cost to process recyclables (Trash = \$53/ton; Recycling = \$5/ton).

Because of the contamination, the Town's recycling tonnage is decreasing while trash tonnage is on the rise, resulting in a significant increase in processing costs. Residents are encouraged to diligently recycle according to the specifications included in the County Guide. For your convenience, a copy of the guide is included with your tax bill. It is also available at the Town Hall and posted on the Town's website.
