## **Hazardous Materials**

### **Household Hazardous Materials**

are found in sheds, garages,

basements, craft rooms, workshops or under kitchen sinks in many homes. Often these products are labeled with words



such as: Caution, Warning, Danger, Poison, Flammable, Combustible or Corrosive.



### Agricultural **Hazardous Materials**

such as pesticides, herbicides, solvents and other chemicals are found on both active and abandoned farms. Banned substances like DDT, Chlordane, and Silvex, 2, 4-D will be accepted.

### **Business Hazardous Materials**

will be accepted from businesses identified as Very Small Quantity

Generators (VSQGs) and located in Winnebago County. COMBUSTIBLE FLAMMABLE Businesses must pay for their disposal costs,



but may avoid on-site pick up fees. Eligible businesses may receive a 50% subsidy for disposal of pesticide wastes.

Farmers and residents of Winnebago County may dispose of hazardous materials free of charge. Monetary donations will be accepted. Material accepted by appointment only.

### Why participate in this event?

### A better choice for your health, a better choice for your community.

When disposed of improperly, household and agricultural hazardous materials can threaten the quality of our drinking water, increase the threat of algae bloom, and threaten the safety of sanitation workers. Don't risk accidental exposure. Hazardous materials left around the house and farm pose an accidental poison risk to children and pets.

### Want to reduce the use of hazardous materials in your home?

Read product labels; if words like Caution, Warning, Danger, Flammable, Combustible, Reactive, Corrosive, Poison or Toxic appear on the label, look for an alternative, non-hazardous product. Buy only what you need; if you can't use it all, look for storage instructions on the label, leave the product in its original container and use child-resistant lids. Share excess with friends and relatives. Proper disposal; research local hazardous material disposal options prior to pitching old or unused hazardous products.

- Appointments are required.
- Household containers are typically 5 gallons or less in size. Household or agricultural containers larger than 5 gallons must be reported when scheduling your appointment.
- Please identify the material source (i.e. your home, active/abandoned farm, business).
- This service is free of charge for household and agricultural material. Monetary donations will be accepted to help offset program costs.

### The following items WILL NOT be accepted at the Clean Sweep Events.

- Latex paint
- Motor oil, Antifreeze
- Light bulbs, Ballasts
- **Electronic devices** (TVs, computers, printers, etc.)
- Propane cylinders, Gas tanks, Fire extinguishers
- Vehicle & household batteries
- Ammunition, Explosives, Flares
- Radioactive material (smoke detectors)
- Appliances (microwaves, stoves dehumidifiers, etc.)
- Medical waste (sharps, medication, bio-hazards, etc.)
