Preferred Payment Method: **Checks or Money Orders** payable to the *Town of Winchester*.
Cash payments accepted for **exact amount** only.

First Installments or Full Payments are due by January 31, 2025.

Options for making tax payments are as follows:

In-Person: At the Town office.

Beginning December 16:

MONDAYS

December 16, 23, 30 and all in January
from 2:00-5:00 p.m.

TUESDAYS and THURSDAYS

December 17, 19, 26, 31 and all in January
from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

SATURDAYS

December 21 and 28 and January 25
from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Proof of Rabies Vaccination is REQUIRED

(please send a COPY—it may NOT be returned)

Application form(s) are NOT necessary IF owner name, address, and phone is included on the Rabies Certificate. Please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope with license requests.

Neutered and Spayed \$ 5.00 each
Intact Males and Females \$10.00 each
Multiple Dog License \$40.00 (Max 12 Tags)

Any dog registered on/after April 1st will be charged a \$10.00 late fee unless it is a new dog.
