

Place the items listed below in your recycling cart:

- Aluminum cans and clean aluminum foil
- Tin cans, steel cans, aerosol cans, empty/dried paint cans
- Glass bottles and jars
- Plastic containers (types #1-#7)
- Newspaper, magazines, books, mail, school/office paper
- Corrugated cardboard
- Cereal and shoe boxes
- Paper bags

Do **NOT** place recycling in plastic bags.

Do **NOT** put the items listed below in your recycling cart:

- Plastic bags
- Styrofoam of any kind
- Trash
- Construction materials
- Clothing
- Yard Waste
- Household hazardous waste
- Shredded paper (bagged or loose)

Snowplowing across Roadways is Dangerous

Pushing snow onto or across roads from private driveways can cause accidents, death, and/or snowplow and vehicle damage, and is **prohibited by Wisconsin Law Statutes** 86.01, 86.07, 346.94, and/or 941.03. Avoid penalty and liability by managing snow on your own property. Please do not place snow piles in the roadside ditches as this practice often impedes drainage especially in the spring. Your cooperation provides for safer roads. Thank you!



Grass Clippings are Dangerous on Roadways

Grass clippings, leaves, gravel, sticks, and other debris blown on the road creates extremely dangerous conditions for passing motorcycles, bicycles, and even cars. The grass clippings are like ice, creating very slippery conditions. Any debris in the road including grass clippings is dangerous and could potentially cause an accident, injury, or even death. **Wisconsin Law Statutes 86.01**, **86.07**, **346.94**, **and/or 941.03**, as well as local ordinance, prohibit the practice. Avoid penalty and liability by managing your yard waste on your own property. Thank you!
