Household Hazardous Materials

Check the labels! Many of the household materials accepted are labeled as corrosive, poison, flammable or combustible. Examples include:

Service is available to Winnebago County residents with household sourced materials from personal use. This is a seasonal collection facility accepting material by appointment only, May - October, 2025. Appointment dates will open 4-weeks in advance.

What do I do with alkaline batteries?

Alkaline batteries are not considered hazardous and not collected at this facility. Alkaline batteries may be placed in your household trash for disposal.
