THE WORK UNDER THIS CONTRACT SHALL CONSIST OF MISCELLANEOUS REMOVALS, EXCAVATION COMMON, BASE AGGREGATE DENSE, HMA PAVEMENT, REMOVE AND REPLACE CROSS CULVERT AND DRIVEWAY CULVERT PIPES, SIGNAGE, RESTORATION AND ALL INCIDENTAL ITEMS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE WORK.

Failure on the part of the bidder to do so will result in forfeiture of the bidder's Bid Bond as liquidated damages.

**BID REJECTION and WITHDRAWAL:** The Town of Winchester reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids, waive any irregularities in bidding, or to accept any bid it deems most advantageous to the Town. No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of thirty (30) days after the scheduled opening of the bids without the consent of the Town of Winchester
